# UNM Department of Anthropology Requirement for the Undergraduate Honors Program

The Honors Program provides intensive and personal instruction to outstanding undergraduate students who intend to pursue graduate or professional study.

#### Requirements for acceptance into the Honors Program

- Minimum grade point average of 3.5
- Approval of the "Undergraduate Honors Program Application" by a full-time faculty member of the Department of Anthropology
- Submission of the Undergraduate Honors Program Application by the end of the fall semester of the junior year
- Completion of ANTH 498 Honors Seminar with a minimum grade of A-
- Completion of ANTH 497 Individual Research with a minimum grade of A-
- Submission of an <u>Assignment of Honors</u> form at least three weeks prior to the last day of the semester of graduation

### Requirements for successful completion of the Honors program

- Submission of an Honors Thesis at least four weeks prior to the last day of the semester of graduation
- Approval of the Honors Thesis by a committee of at least two faculty members formed by the faculty mentor
- Minimum grade point average of 3.5 or higher at the time of graduation
- The Undergraduate Advisor must:
  - submit a memo on department letterhead to the Office of the Secretary for the UNM Convocation
  - o contact the Office of the Registrar to register the level of honors

#### Additional information

- Students may submit a petition to waive one or more of the Requirements for acceptance into the Honors Program. Send inquiries to the Undergraduate Advisor.
- The level of honors (*cum laude, magna cum laude,* or *summa cum laude*) will be assigned by the committee formed by the faculty mentor
- Anth 497 must be taken in the spring semester of the student's junior year
- Anth 498 must be taken in the fall semester of the student's senior year
