Students must enroll in three linked full semester courses (13 credit hrs) with a service learning component (2 credit hrs). Students study on the UNM main campus August xx to September, 25th. The field school takes place in Chaco Culture National Historic Park from September 26th to November 4th. Student return to campus from November 5th to December xx.



Instruction includes:

- Introduction to Chaco archaeology
- Fundamentals of research design
- Site survey
- Excavation methods and mapping
- Introduction to remote sensing techniques
- Artifact analysis
- Field reports
- Archaeological ethics

Total Costs:

- Course Fee: \$850.00 (transportation and food at Chaco)
- Tuition: Undergraduate resident: \$2,578.50 (est.)
- Undergraduate non-resident: \$ 10,023.96 (est.)
- Graduate resident: \$ 3810.00 (est.)
- Graduate non-resident \$ \$10,301.00 (est.)



Chaco Canyon is in San Juan County, New Mexico.

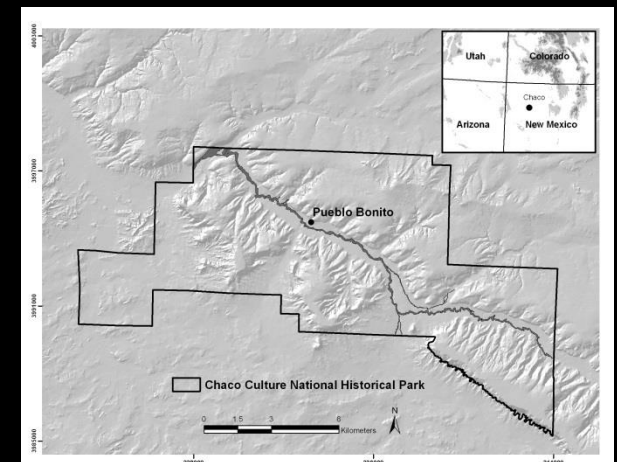
During the field school session, students live in the VIP campground, which has a kitchen, shower house, and lab area. Students provide their own camping gear.



Weekly schedule: Sunday afternoon to Friday afternoon. Transportation provided from UNM Main Campus to and from Chaco.

**Daily schedule: ca. 6 am to 9 pm.
Field work from 7 am to 3 pm. Lab/lecture from 6:30 to 9:00 pm.**

Students must be able to perform strenuous labor and walk several miles each day.
