

ANTHROPOLOGY STUDENT TRAVEL AWARD APPLICATION

The Anthropology Student Travel Award is for students in good standing who are participating in a conference to cover travel, food, lodging, conference fees, etc. Travel awards can be up to \$500 each and cover any time of that academic year for travel through June 16th. Applications can also be retroactive or in advance of one semester (for example in cases where an abstract was accepted and conference attended after previous deadline). Each of the three subfield is limited to one award per semester, dependent on funding availability. Students can receive funds only every other year (more often if there are no other qualified candidates), and there is a limit of three total travel awards during a student's time at the University of New Mexico. Criteria for these awards include: seniority, timely progress, and strength of application. Please see the Graduate Student Funding Guide for more information.
